LATE WITHDRAWAL OF ENTERED HORSES

The OC reserves the right to seek an indemnity of \in 200,00 per horse/ \in 150,00 per YH & Jun horse from definitely-entered participants who withdraw one or more horses from the event after 12.00 a.m. on Thursday 30 June 2011. In the event that an athlete withdraws all of his horses after the indicated deadline, the OC reserves the right if necessary to seek said indemnity via the athlete's NF. This does not preclude of substitute any action on the part of the FEI subsequent to mention of late or unadvised withdrawals in the Foreign Judge's report.

IV. FACILITIES OFFERED (Art. 132, 133)

1. ATHLETES



A list of hotels will be sent to every participant together with the schedule. For any booking the athletes are invited to call directly the hotels. All accounts are to be settled by those who incur them. The OC will not be responsible for any travelling or living expenses. Athletes will receive their passes and identification numbers from the Show Office on payment of entry fees.

2. **GROOMS** Requests for accommodation must be sent with entries.

A sufficient number of WCs and hot-water showers will be available. (**† †**) The OC will not be responsible for any travelling or living expense.

3. HORSES

The OC will not be responsible for any travelling or feeding expenses.

Horses must be stabled in the boxes assigned to them on the show ground. Arrival times: **Thursday 7th July** 8.00 am to 5.00 pm. Stables must be mucked out daily and dirty bedding and rubbish placed in the special area. Horses must be stabled within the FEI stable area for the duration of the event .The stables will be closed between 11.00 pm and 6.00 am.

Horses may not leave their boxes without the official show starting number. The OC must be informed of any athletes intending to bring non-competing horses. A charge of \in 150,00 will be levied for each non-competing horse to cover stabling costs. Non-competing horses must be presented at the Horse Inspection for identification and vaccination control.

Departure: all horses have to leave the venue by 5 a.m. on Monday 11th July 2011. <u>Any athlete wishing to leave later</u> than this time is requested to write it on the entry form.

FEI passport not required for Horses in their Country of Nationality (art 137.2)

4. ADDITIONAL FEES (VAT incl.)

All further fees (i.e electricity, etc.) must be listed hereunder with the details of the amounts to be charged. These must have received FEI Approval before being included in the published schedule. Only fees approved by the FEI and listed in the approved schedule can be charged by the OC.

Participants who will need electricity for their live-in horseboxes and caravans can receive it paying a sum of \in 10,00 per day . The OC will only guarantee electricity to those who make their request together with the definite entries.

5. WELCOME

The time and date of arrival of athletes and horses and their means of transport must be given to the OC in order to assist them on arrival.

6. LOCAL TRANSPORTATION - ARRANGEMENTS FROM HOTEL TO SHOWGROUNDS - Local Transportation The OC will not provide transportation for horses or athletes (including airport transportation) but is able to organise the same upon receipt of written request. All accounts are to be settled by those who incur them.

7. ADVERTISING AND PUBLICITY ON ATHLETES AND HORSES (Art. 136.1-2)

The Athletes **are** authorised to carry the logo of their personal sponsor on the saddle cloth in accordance with Art. 256.3 and 257.3 of the FEI Rules for Jumping. The Chief Steward will check that the advertising and publicity on Athletes and horses complies with these Articles.

3. PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

At the end of each class, the first **10** athletes shall enter the main arena for the Presentations. Athletes must ride the horse on which they competed unless excused by the Ground Jury (art. 248.5). The owner of the winning horse is invited to the prize giving ceremony for the Grand Prix.

4. DEDUCTIONS FROM PRIZE MONEY

The prize money includes government taxes. Athlete with fiscal residency in Italy: <u>no</u> <u>taxation</u> up to 7.500,00€, <u>23,9%</u> for those having won more than 7.500,00€ in the current year. Athlete without fiscal residency in Italy: <u>taxation 30%</u>.

5. INSURANCES

All owners and athletes are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.

The Organising Committee renounces all responsibility for any injures occurring to owners, athletes, horses and stable staff caused by accidents and/or illness, and for all loss of property due to theft, damages, fire or mishaps, and to any damage to electronic/electrical appliances used by participants throughout the venue due to incidents with the power supply including but not limited to power surges. The participants will meet all repatriation costs following any accidents.

Through their entry in the competition, the participants accept that the OC and its agents cannot be held responsible for any accidents during the events and the duration of their stay at the same.

All participating horses must be in possession of:

- 1) a declaration (with a detailed list) from their own NF stating that the same is temporarily imported into Italy to take part in CSI PREDAZZO;
- an ATA form, especially for extra European Countries or in the case the horse will pass through not EU Countries (crossing not communitarian nations) (for further information see: <u>http://www.atacarnet.com/</u>);
- 3) official veterinary health certificates on the International Form issued from the official veterinary health authorities of the Country of origin
 - a) for horses from European Countries see Annex B of Council Directive 1990/426 EC and subsequent amendment (please remember that this Annex B still in force only 10 days);
 - b) for horses from NOT European Countries see Council Directive 1992/260 EC and Commission Decision 2004/211 EC and respective subsequent amendment.

It is obligatory for all horses based and travelling around Italy to result negative to the serum test of E.I.A (Equine Infectious Anaemia) – All foreign riders are STRONGLY ADVISED to produce the same negative test on the official documents of their horses.

THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- 1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- 2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- 3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- 4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.

5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.


