IV. FACILITIES OFFERED

1. ATHLETES

- ❖ The OC has obtained special tariffs from some hotels and restaurant near Manerbio. Those wishing to take advantage of these conditions are requested to contact the Show Secretary in advance and in writing for details. All accounts are to be settled by those who incur them.
- ❖ The OC will not be responsible for any travelling or living expenses. Competitors will receive their passes and identification numbers from the Show Office on payment of entry fees.

2. GROOMS

- ❖ No accommodation is provided for grooms by OC.
- ❖ Sufficient sanitary and showering facilities for male and female grooms, with hot and cold water, will be provided by the OC.

3. HORSES

- ❖ No facilities are offered for transportation of horses.
- ❖ The OC will not be responsible for any travelling or feeding expenses
- ❖ Arrivals time: **17th October from 02.00 p.m. to 08.00 p.m. and 18th October from 08.00 a.m. to 08.00 p.m.**
- ❖ Stables will be allocated on arrival but **please make special requests** with definitive entries.
- ❖ All horses will be bedded on **shavings** unless specifically requested otherwise with entries.
- ❖ Horses must be stabled within the FEI stable area for the duration of the event. The stables will be closed one hour after the end of the last competition to 06.30 am. No horse may leave the stable area during the closing time without the specific authorization of the Chief Steward unless there is an emergency.
- ❖ Horses may not leave their boxes without the official show starting number.
- ❖ Horses taking part in **CSI1*/CSIYH1*** in their Country of nationality are not required to have an FEI passport (GRs art 137.2)

4. ADDITIONAL FEES (all VAT included)

- ❖ Lived-in horse boxes/caravans will be charged **€ 35,00** for the duration of the show for electricity. The OC will **only** guarantee electricity to those who make their request together with the definite entries.
- ❖ It is possible to have stable arrangements before **Monday 17th October 2011** for horses that are in Italy for some other Shows only if requested with definite Entries (**€ 40,00** per horse each day).
- ❖ The first bedstead is provided by the OC free of charge. It is possible to buy shavings (**€ 15,00**), and hay (**€ 15,00**) paying at the secretary office.
- ❖ The OC must be informed by **11th October 2011** of any riders intending to bring non-competing horses. A charge of **€ 100,00** will be levied for each non-competing horse to cover stabling cost.
- ❖ The OC must be informed by **11th October 2011** of any riders intending to have box for equipments. A charge of **€ 100,00** will be levied for each box request.
- ❖ The OC charge a manure disposal fee of **€ 20,00** for each horse.

Non-competing horses must be presented at the Horse Inspection for identification and vaccination control.

THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. **The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.**
