1. MEALS

Friday lunch and dinner, & Saturday lunch are in charge of the O.C.

Hotel is in charge of the rider.

2. WELCOME

The time and date of arrival of athletes and horses and their means of transport must be done on Friday morning.

The veterinary book and a vaccination of less than 6 months will be asked.

3. ADVERTISING AND PUBLICITY ON ATHLETES AND HORSES

The Athletes **are** authorised to carry the logo of their personal sponsor on the saddle cloth in accordance with Art. 256.3 and 257.3 of the FEI Rules for Jumping. The Chief Steward will check that the advertising and publicity on Athletes and horses complies with these Articles.

VI. MISCELLANEOUS:

1. INSURANCES

All owners and athletes are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.

FURTHER DETAILS:

In case of canceling, riders can not submit any complains against the O.C. or receive any financial compensation. However, the amount of their entry fee will be repaid.

The O.C. is free to use pictures or movies made during the event in the event area.



THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- 1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- 2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- 3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- 4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.

5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.
