Each NF may send, after receiving an invitation from the Organising Committee, 2 Athletes with 1 horse each. In exceptional cases only one rider per NF will be invited by the OC.

All riders must compete in both competitions.

6. ENTRIES

Attention: All Athletes & Horses participating in any International competition must be registered with the FEI.

Certificates of Capability:

Only competitors and horses qualified for the Championship may be entered. The procedure of qualification as published by the FEI, must be strictly followed and can be found on the FEI website.

The deadline date for obtaining a certificate of capability is 19th July 2011.

Entries in Principle: Monday 28th February 2011

Each NF must declare whether they intend to participate with a team or with individual competitors.

Nominated Entries: Monday 18th July 2011

Each NF may enter a maximum of 8 competitors and 16 horses. For all competitors and horses entered, a Certificate of Capability must be confirmed on the FEI website. The name and address of the team veterinarian has to be included with the entries.

Entry forms must include the following information:

Horses: name of horse • date of birth • breed • country of birth • stud-book initials • FEI passport number/FEI horse registration number • colour • sex • name(s) of owner(s) and qualifying results.

Each NF may enter a maximum of 4 competitors and 4 horses or up to 2 individual competitors with 1 horse each. All competitors and horses must be chosen from the list of nominative entries.

Entry fee per horse EC Dressage 2011: € 500,- (excl. VAT)

Entry fee per horse CDIU25: € 300,- (excl. VAT) MCP Fee: Equivalent of CHF12,50 per horse

All entries must be submitted using the HippoBase online entry system. The OC and the FEI will regard the data supplied online as the only official entry information. Any information sent to the OC by email or fax, which could also be entered directly into the online system, will not be accepted. The FEI will approve participation (certificates of capability) based on qualifying results entered into the system. \checkmark

All competitors have to be entered by their home NF.

"NB: Withdrawals after the date of definite entries or no-shows will be held liable to reimburse the OC for the actual financial loss incurred by the OC (i.e. stabling and hotel expenses) as a result of the late withdrawal or no-show."

The Organising Committee reserves the right to withhold money due from the prize money won, as long as outstanding bills have not been paid. Payments must be made in € (Euro).

General

Entries are accepted subject to any unforeseen circumstances including but not limited to military exigencies, strikes, or other civil disturbances, fire or other contingencies of any description preventing or rendering it undesirable in the opinion of the Organising Committee for the Show to take place.

All entries shall stand for any postponed show unless withdrawn by written notice to the Show Secratary within one week of notification or public announcement in the press of such postponement.

The postponement or abandonment of the show either before the opening or at any time during the course of the show shall not give rise to any claim whatever against the show or the Organising Committee by the competitors or others except for refund of prepaid entries in respect of classes or competitions not held. In the case of postponement refund will only be made in respect of entries duly withdrawn.

Declining entries

The organising Committee may at their absolute discretion, with Ground Jury approval, remove any person or animal from the event without being liable for any compensation. No decision will however be taken by the Organising Committee relating to riders and/or horses participating in international competition without the approval of the Ground Jury.

D) HORSES

Horses will be stabled free of charge in boxes (3m x 3m) on the show grounds. The Championship stables will be open from noon on Saturday 13^{th} August till Noon Monday 22^{nd} August 2011. \checkmark

First bedding - reasonable quantities will be made available free of charge by the OC. Additional supplies will be available for purchase from the Fodder Stored throughout the event.

Any rider requiring straw or shavings should order this in advance through the Hippobase Entry System.

Hard Feed and Fodder will be the responsibility of the individual competitor although supplies of Feeds will be available for purchase. Orders for hard feed should be made from the Fodder Store prior to 4.00 PM on any day for delivery by 8.00 AM the following morning.



Electrical supply for live-in-lorries will be made available at a cost of \le 65,00 for the whole show Incl. VAT and must be ordered per vehicle through the Hippobase Entry System.

E) WELCOME

3. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ENTRY OF HORSES

Every competitor is supplied to deliver all necessary certificates of health for the transport to the event or identification of the horses before they come into the stables:

- a) In case of arrival from a EU-member country, a certificate for registered horses acc. To sample of Annex B to Reglements 90/426 of the actual valid form will be necessary.
- b) In case of arrival from a country not concerning to the EU, a certificate of health for registered horses etc. To sample of annex II of the decision of the commission 92/260 of the actual valid form will be necessary.

A certificate must be done in at least on official language of the country of destination and in one official language of the member country. The competitor must carry with him the original certificate, not a copy.

The organiser sees to it that on the competition site, an official state veterinarian is present to issue the health certificates which are necessary for the transport of the horses to their destination abroad.

In case the OC has entrusted to a forwarding agency, the latter is ready to assist regarding the required documents.

Furthermore, questions relating to health requirements for horses can be directed to the veterinary authorities in the country of origin or in the Netherlands.

Veterinary and medical assistance, as well as farriery services, are available for the duration of the event. These are at the expense of those requesting them.

When, in the opinion of the Show's veterinary surgeon, a horse is so severely injured that it ought to be humanely destroyed, the Person Responsible should where possible first be informed. However, the Show's veterinary surgeon may proceed with humane destruction, without reference to the PR, in order to prevent undue suffering to the horse.

Before taking this action, the Show's veterinary surgeon should, wherever practicable, seek a second veterinary opinion. In such eventuality, owners are responsible for the cost of disposal.

Private Veterinary surgeons

Private and/or team veterinaries will have to report to the FEI Veterinary Delegate upon their arrival at the show grounds, before they will be accredited and be allowed to enter the restricted area.

Under no circumstance will any veterinary surgeon other than the veterinary commission be allowed to treat any horse at the EC Dressage 2011, unless permission in writing has been received from the President of the Veterinary Commission. If permission is given, the veterinary concerned will be accompanied by the FEI Veterinary Delegate or by his representative.

MISCELLANEOUS

A) PROTEST

Each protest must be made and signed by the Chef d'Equipe or persons responsible and be forwarded within the time prescribed. All protest to be valid must be made in writing and accompanied by a deposit of CHF 150,- or equivalent.

C) PRIZE - CLASSIFICATION

Prize money won will be paid in Euros and transferred to a provided bank account number which includes the International Bank Account Number (IBAN) and Bank Identifier Code (BIC) and name and address of the bank. Also necessary is a passport copy of the concerned competitors. Entry fees, MCP fees, etc. Will be deducted.

D) PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

The numbers 1 up to and including 15 (and the three best teams) must present themselves with horses for the prize-giving ceremony of each competition.

The Athletes may, in special circumstances only, take a borrowed horse following approval of President of the Ground Jury and Foreign Judge. However, horses must be appropriate dressage horses and must be ridden on double bridle. Upon request of the Organising Committee the Athletes have to demonstrate some movements of the respective competition.

E) DEDUCTIONS FROM PRIZE MONEY

Allocation of money prizes will be based on one prize for each four competitors, with a minimum of five prizes per competition.

In accordance with the relevant specific Dutch tax regulations, no income tax will be deducted from prizes won by home riders or by foreign riders from a country with which the Netherlands have made a treaty in order to avoid double income tax levies. However, 20% income tax will be deducted from prize money won by foreign competitors, domiciled in a country with which The Netherlands do not have a similar tax treaty.

In all cases, competitors will be invited to provide all necessary information, in order to guarantee the correct tax procedure; to this purpose all competitors must provide the Organising Committee with a copy of the relevant pages of their passport and their home address. Every competitor is responsible for the correctness of the details he/she submits.

According to the relevant Dutch tax regulations, the Organising Committee of CHIO Rotterdam / EC Dressage 2011 must charge 6% VAT on all fees to be paid by competitors. NFs and individual competitors will receive an invoice, showing VAT specified separately and can apply for re-imbursement of all VAT paid at the CHIO Rotterdam / EC Dressage 2011 by filling out a form to request this refund of VAT by the Dutch tax authorities.

Within six months maximum after the end of the year in which the event took place. Requests for amounts smaller than € (EUR) 27,00 will not be taken into consideration. Any such request can be handed in once a year only.

E) LIABILITY / INSURANCES

All owners and Athletes are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are



therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date.

The Organising Committee and all persons working for the Organising Committee shall not be liable for any material or physical damage, accident or illness which may occur to Athletes, horse owners and renters, horses, grooms and visitors, under any circumstances, within or out of the competition ground before, during or after the competitions. The Organising Committee and all persons working for the Organising Committee shall not be liable for damage to driving vehicles, saddlery, stable attachment and other property (including theft and loss).

The competitor indemnifies the Organising Committee and all persons working for the Organising Committee from liability with regard to claims made by third parties, including the owners and renters of the horses, for compensation by the Organising Committee and all persons working for the OC for all material or physical damage, of whatever nature, suffered by these third parties.

By making the definite entries for the CHIO Rotterdam / EC Dressage 2011 each Athlete declares that he/she has taken notice of the schedule and the exclusion of the liability as set out in the schedule and that the competitor explicitly agrees therewith.

The use of properly fastened protective riding headgear is strongly recommended when training and at warm-ups at CDIs.

F) EVENT'S ORGANISATION

In exceptional circumstances, together with the approval of the Ground Jury the Organising Committee reserves the right to modify the schedule in order to clarify any matters or matters arising from an omission or due to unforeseen circumstances.

Any such changes will be notified to all competitors and officials as soon as possible and they will be reported to the Secretary General of the FEI by the Foreign Judge. All modifications made to the schedule after approval by the Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) must have the approval of the Jumping Director of the FEI

The Organising Committee reserves to themselves the right to alter the timings or cancel any of the competitions, as necessities of the programme may require, providing FEI approval has been given.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to take all necessary action, including cancelling or shortening the CHIO Rotterdam / EC Dressage 2011, due to special and/or unforeseen circumstances, which in the opinion of the Organising Committee, would make the continuation of the event unjustified; any such decision will be taken in agreement with the Jumping Director of the FEI. No consequential liability whatsoever can be accepted in such occasion. Gen.Reg. 115.1 and 115.2. Entry fees paid will however be returned.

At least one of the names of the horse owners to be accreditated must correspond with the horse owners registered in the FEI passport of the horse (GR Art. 132.1)

The owner of the show pass accepts the show ground regulations as well as the accreditation rules of the EC Dressage 2011. On the show days, the show pass is valid for bus transfer to and from the show grounds with all EC Dressage 2011 busses. In case of loss, a new show pass will be issued for a fee of € 50,-.

THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- 1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- 2. Horses and athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
- 3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
- 4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
- 5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.
