- Lived-in horse boxes/caravans will receive electricity **€ 10,00** per day. The OC will **only** guarantee electricity to those who make their request together with the definite entries.

2. GROOMS

No accommodation is provided for grooms by OC.

- Sufficient sanitary and showering facilities for male and female grooms, with hot and cold water, will be provided by the OC.

OCs must provide sufficient sanitary and showering facilities, with hot and cold water for male and female grooms. These must be regularly maintained in a proper state of cleanliness.

3. HORSES

No facilities are offered for transportation of horses.

- Stables will be allocated on arrival but PLEASE MAKE SPECIAL REQUESTS (e.g. stallions) with definitive entries.
- All horses will be bedded on **shavings**.
- Horses must be stabled within the FEI stable area for the duration of the event.
- Stables will be closed between 10.00 PM and 6.30 AM
- No horse may leave the stable area during the closing time without the specific authorization of the Chief Steward unless there is an emergency.
- Horses may not leave their boxes without the official show starting number.

DEPARTURE: all horses must leave the venue by 9:00 am on Monday 16/05/11

2. PRIZE - CLASSIFICATION (Art. 126, 127, 128)

3. PRIZE GIVING CEREMONY

At the end of each class, the first 8 competitors shall enter the main arena for the presentations. Athletes must ride the horse on which they competed, unless excused by the Ground Jury (Art. 248.5)

4. DEDUCTIONS FROM PRIZE MONEY

According to Italian Law

The O. C. will deduct from the prize money the following taxes:

23,9% for the Italian riders who has won more than € 7.500,00 during the current year

30,0% for all foreign riders

5. INSURANCES

Details pertaining to insurance of athletes, horses etc. Responsibility of OC for damages, fire, theft etc.

All owners and athletes are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. They are therefore strongly advised to take out third-party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events at home and abroad, and to keep the policy up to date. The Organising Committee renounces all responsibility for

any injuries occurring to owners, athletes, horses and stable staff caused by accidents and/or illness, and for all loss of property due to theft, damages, fire or mishaps and to any damage to electronic/electrical appliance used by participants throughout the venue due to incidents with the power supply including but not limited to power surges. The participants will meet all repatriation costs following any accidents.

Through their entry in the competition, the participants accept that the OC and its agents cannot be held responsible for any accidents during the events and the duration of their stay at the same.

- 3) official veterinary health certificates on the International Form issued from the official veterinary health authorities of the Country of origin
 - a) for horses from European Countries see Annex B of Council Directive 1990/426 EC and subsequent amendment (please remember that this Annex B still in force only 10 days);
 - b) for horses from NOT European Countries see Council Directive 1992/260 EC and Commission Decision 2004/211 EC and respective subsequent amendment.

It is obligatory for all horses based and travelling around Italy to result negative to the serum test of E.I.A (Equine Infectious Anaemia) – All foreign riders are **STRONGLY ADVISED** to produce the same negative test on the official documents of their horses

Details on compulsory health tests and, where applicable, quarantine periods and protocol, etc. PLEASE APPEND SPECIMEN IMPORT LICENCES WHICH WILL BE APPLIED TO HORSES ATTENDING THIS EVENT. In case of doubt or problems, please contact the FEI Veterinary Department as soon as possible.

THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT

FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. **The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.**
